Discover Cape York Peninsula NOW BOOKING 2012



Departing from Cairns we will follow the coastal road north to the World Heritage listed Daintree National Park and visit the world's oldest tropical rainforest. See the Wet Tropics World Heritage Area - Mossman Gorge with its picturesque rivers, and diverse flora and fauna. You will stay right in the little town of Daintree for a night, and cruise down the winding Daintree River, enjoy a catered dinner with your new found tag along friends at the Daintree Village.



After crossing the famous Daintree River Ferry you will visit the Daintree Discovery Centre. Head north to Cooktown for a couple of nights, via the Bloomfield Track. On the way you will visit Bloomfield Falls, the Lion's Den Hotel and the mysterious Black Mountain .

At Cooktown you will be guided by a local for an Historical Town Tour by coach .

On this Historical Town Tour you will hear about Captain Cook, The Endeavour disaster in 1770, and the real history of "The first white settlement in Australia", The discovery of the land of Australia and what part the

Endeavour River played in it, The birth of Cooktown - once the second largest town and port in Queensland, wild times during the gold rush and entry into the James Cook Museum.

Departing Cooktown via The Battle Camp Road will lead us to a good camp in Lakefield NP. Here more than two hundred bird species have been recorded, crocs also inhabit this area. Majestic termite mounds are numerous in this NP.



The adventure continues as we spend a night on the banks of Archer River. Following the East Coast, to the Iron Range NP we will chill out on Chili Beach for a couple of nights.

Heading North your 4wd and camper trailer will have a work out with the changing conditions on the track, from water to bull dust, sand and mud, the Frenchman's track has it all. The Morton Telegraph Station will be a well deserved rest stop.

Heading north on the generally narrow Old Telegraph Track, we will see its beautiful creek crossings and awesome swimming holes with waterfalls, and an ever changing landscape. A cool swim with a couple of nights camping on this track is delightful. The creek crossings change as the wet seasons pass, so the OTL is a new adventure each year!



After crossing the Jardine River, via the barge, we will enter into the local Injinoos community and spend a few days at Seisia where we will visit 'The Tip' of Australia, the Croc Tent and Frangipani Bay. As we take the board walk to the tip we will taste some green ants, a common bush food. Seisia wharf is arguably the best land fishing in Australia. You'll travel through the Torres Strait to Thursday Island and meet the gentle Thursday Island people. Here you will take an interesting bus tour and visiting a number of historic and scenic sites

before returning on the ferry to the mainland for a group catered dinner at Seisia Island Breeze Restaurant.

Returning across the Jardine River, via the barge, we will travel west to the lesser known aboriginal owned coastline of Vrilya Point, with its beautiful sandy beach and great fishing spots, we will relax here around a friendly campfire for a couple of days and go for a beach drive.

Returning to the OTL is so much fun that we enjoy another day swimming at the falls and camping on the Old Telegraph Line, followed by the mining town of Weipa. At Weipa you will take a guided bus tour of the Weipa mines and town, this will provide you with an excellent insight into the whole mining process at Weipa. You can book your own optional fishing charter and catch your very own Barramundi! Weipa has the prettiest sunsets that we have ever seen, be sure



to take your camera, chair and nibbles to the afternoon beach sunset gathering.

Returning south, we visit the old telegraph station at Musgrave, which was built in 1887 and now stands as a welcome roadhouse and camping ground. Heading south you will see some Quinkan Ancient Rock Art which has been said to be some of the oldest rock art in the world. Finally you will return to Cairns for our final night on your amazing Cape York adventure.
